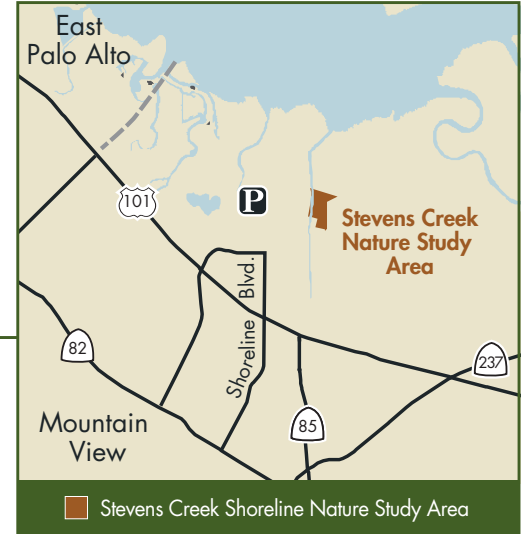




# Stevens Creek Shoreline Nature Study Area

After passing the entrance kiosk, turn right into the “Kite Area” parking lot.



## Trail Use

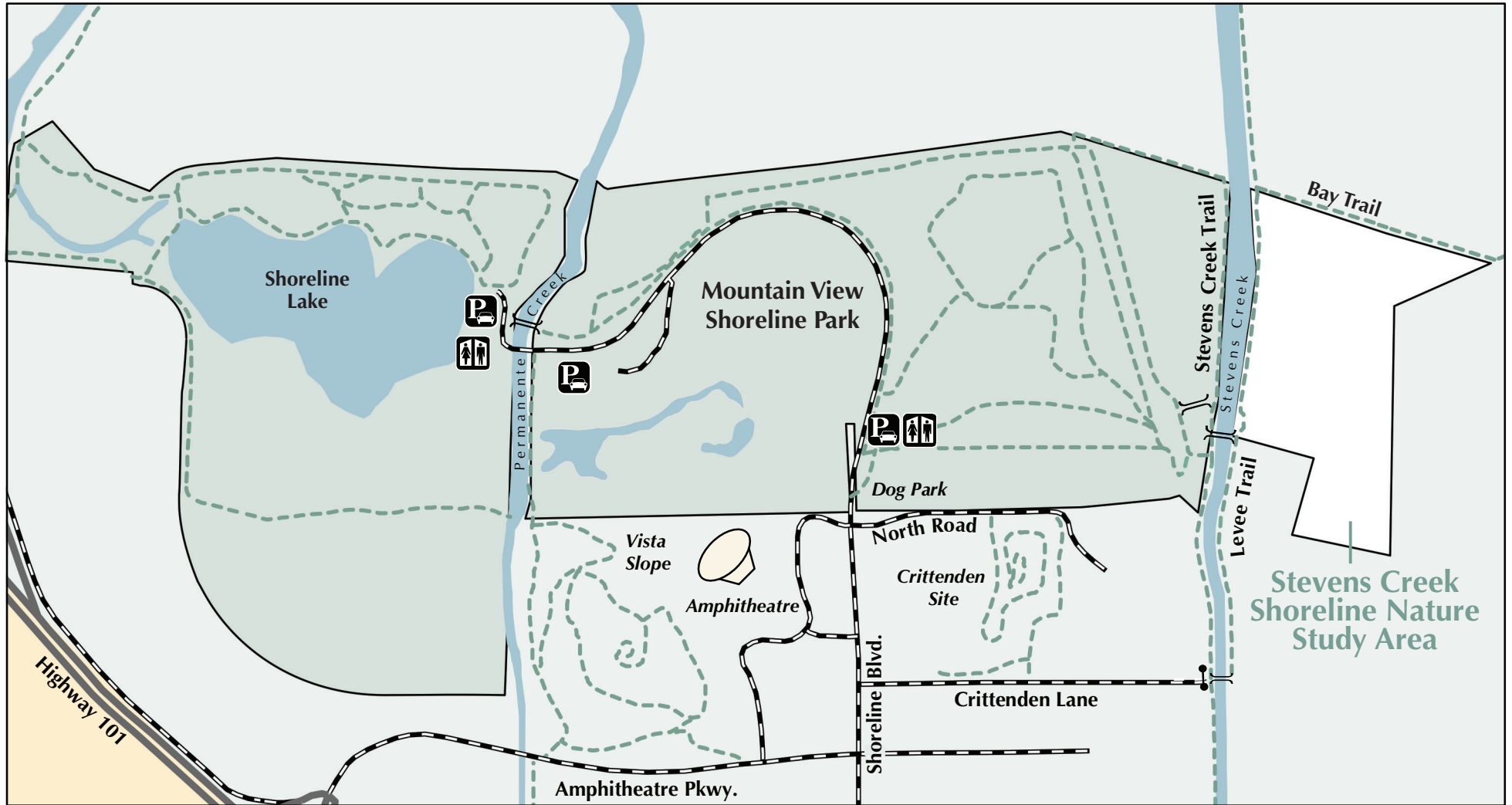
