Midpen moves consideration of conservation easement at Mount Umunhum to December 13

Los Altos, CA— The Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's board of directors has moved a vote on whether to enter into a conservation easement over 36 acres atop Mount Umunhum with the Amah Mutsun Tribal Band to the December 13 meeting. The agenda item was moved from the December 6 meeting following public request.

The conservation easement will be considered at a board of directors meeting on Wednesday, December 13 at 6pm at 330 Distel Circle, Los Altos, CA 94022.
