

## Slender False Brome (SFB) Reimbursement Plan with Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District (MROSD) and San Mateo County Resource Conservation District (RCD)

Reimbursement = \$350 per acre treated.

## Slender False Brome Management Program Steps

- 1. Homeowner & RCD schedule Pre-treatment Survey.
- RCD conducts Pre-treatment Survey. Homeowner receives SFB Control Recommendation, a map of SFB infestation on their property, and reimbursement calculation.
- 3. Homeowner agrees with Control Recommendation and reimbursement. Homeowner signs and returns Program Agreement.
- Homeowner applies control practice or hires a professional. RCD will be available for on-site consultation at the start of treatment if necessary.
- 5. RCD conducts Post-treatment Survey and completes Reimbursement Form.
- 6. RCD issues a reimbursement check.

7. Sometimes, with the agreement of the property owner, RCD may bring in a contractor to treat several properties at one time and no reimbursement to property owner is needed.
